

Rules and Regulations for B Haulin' Boxes

- Payment is required before or at time of delivery for the first container.
- Will need to be present and sign for the container at time of delivery or customer will need to mark where they would like the container to be, and relay instructions to driver.
- We do not set containers in the street without a permit from the city which must be obtained by the customer.
- Containers are originally scheduled to be picked up after 2 weeks from being dropped. After two weeks a daily rate of \$3 a day will be charged until the box is picked up.
- We reserve the right to pick up the box at any time after 30 days has elapsed from delivery.
- There will be a trip charge of \$95 if we travel to location and cannot drop or pick up the container.
- Do not overload the containers
 - Nothing hanging over the sides or mounded on top
 - We are not responsible for having to leave things on the ground that do not fit properly in the container
 - We cannot accept loads over 16,000 lbs. Heavy materials like dirt, rock, asphalt, shingles, etc. may reach this limit when the container is only half to $\frac{3}{4}$ full
 - There will be a charge for having to reconfigure items in the container.
- Do not put these items in the container
 - Hazardous Materials
 - Burnt Materials
 - Tires
 - Appliances
 - Freon of any type
 - Wet Concrete (or any other substance that will stick to the box when it dries)
 - Customers will be charged for retrieving or cleaning these items from container.
- We do not accept responsibility for incidental damage to any surfaces or property that is damaged due to the location where the container is dropped. This includes ruts in the yard, cracked, or broken concrete, etc.
- Customer accepts all responsibility for any incidents, injuries or damage to the container while the container is on the property.
